GENESIS: ORIGIN/BEGINNING

As the book of beginnings, Genesis sets the stage for the entire Bible.

It reveals:

- The person and nature of God (Creator, Sustainer, Judge, Redeemer)
- The value and dignity of human beings (made in God's image, saved by grace, used by God in the world)
- The tragedy and consequences of sin (the fall, separation from God, judgment)
- The **promise** and assurance **of salvation** (covenant, forgiveness, promised Messiah)

GENESIS DIVIDED INTO 2 MAIN SECTIONS

Genesis chapters 1-11

Covers at least 2000 years

Emphasizes events:

- 1. Creation (1-2)
- 2. The Fall (3-5)
- 3. The Flood (6-9)
- 4. Dispersion of nations (10-11)

Genesis chapters 12-50

Covers about 350 years

Emphasizes people:

- 1. Abraham (12-25:18)
- 2. Isaac (25:19-27)
- 3. Jacob (28-36)
- 4. Joseph (37-50)

GOD REVEALS WHAT LED TO MAN'S NEED FOR DIVINE REDEMPTION

GOD'S PLAN OF REDEMPTION BEGINS TO BE REVEALED AND CARRIED OUT

WHAT GENESIS 1:1 REVEALS ABOUT GOD

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."

This first verse reveals 3 things about God:

- 1. He is eternal
 - Not bound by time
 - Not bound by space
- 2. He is greater than creation and separate from creation
- 3. He is active in His creation
 - In big things
 - In small things
