“We're here to be worshippers first and workers only second. We take a convert and immediately make a worker out of him. God never meant it to be so. God's identity:

- He is our Creator.
- He is Holy and set apart from His creation and is worthy of worship.
- God works and stops when He finishes what He starts.
- Jesus Christ is our Sabbath rest for eternity through His blood on the cross.

Our identity:

- We are the created
- We rest in the saving work of Christ
- We are designed to worship our Creator
- For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared ahead of time for us to do. Eph 2:10

God = Hebrew “Elohim” means “the strong one”

- This name emphasizes his sovereignty, his authority, reflecting the greatness of His power. Elohim identifies God as the Creator.

LORD = Hebrew “YHWH”. Pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah

- God’s personal name.

God's identity

Elohim – the strong one, all powerful, creator

Jehovah – He is personal and relational

“Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being. Gen 2:7

Hebrew for “formed” is *yatsar*, which means to mold into a form, especially as a potter does with clay...or dirt.

God's identity:

- **He's the giver of life**

Our identity:

- **We are valuable and have worth
because God made us**

What do we know about the garden?

- 1) it was planned and planted by God Himself
- 2) it was mankind's first home
- 3) it contained incredible variety, with "all kinds of trees"
- 4) it was a beautiful place, as the trees were "pleasing to the eye"
- 5) it was a fertile, fruitful place
- 6) it provided nourishment and nutrition, as the trees were "good for food"
- 7) was naturally well-watered by the four rivers
- 8) Later, we read there (2:19-20) were all kinds of animals in the garden
- 9) Adam and Eve were unclothed in the garden (2:25), indicating that they needed no protection whatsoever—the environment, including the climate, was perfectly suited for humanity

God's identity:

- **God is our extravagant provider for everything we need physically, emotionally and spiritually**

Our identity:

- **We are spiritual creations in physical bodies of dust**
- **We have the capacity to make moral choices.**
