

# Types seen in chapter 22

---

Abraham was a *picture/type* of God the Father who “did not spare His own Son, but gave him up for us all (Rom 8:32; John 3:16)

---

Isaac was a *picture/type* of Jesus who was obedient even to death (Phil 2:5-8)

---

The ram was a *picture/type* of Jesus as the substitute offered in our place (Heb 10:5-10)

---

Isaac “returning from death” after 3 days is a *picture/type* of Jesus’ actual resurrection

# Types seen in chapter 24

---

Abraham the Father – a *picture/type* of God the Father who seeks a bride for His Son

---

Isaac (the promised son of miraculous birth, who had been delivered from death to life) a *picture/type* of Jesus the Son

---

Servant (sent to seek a bride for the son) was a *picture/type* of the Holy Spirit

---

Rebecca (the bride who responds immediately that she will go to her groom) is a *picture/type* of The Church – Bride of Christ
